“RATE CONTRACT FROM EMPANELED CONTRACTORS FOR ANTI-TERMITE TREATMENT, GENERAL PEST CONTROL TREATMENT AND RODENT CONTROL TREATMENT WORKS”

A. SCOPE OF WORK

The pest Control Service under the scope of this tender shall be to eliminate/ eradication / alleviate/ control pests/ insects like ants, centi / millipedes, cockroaches, moths, house flies, silverfish, lizards, mosquitoes, rodents, bed bug, snake, other general/ common pests etc. using only permitted insecticides in accordance with Government of India and WHO norms. The frequency of treatments to be done are furnished below:

Sr. No.	Specification of treatment:	Frequency of Treatment
1	ANTI-TERMITE TREATMENT Treatment to junction of walls by drilling 12mm dia holes in every 600 mm and putting termite toxicant Imidacloprid / Fipronil and treatment to entire surface area by spraying of above said medicine.	As well as whenever felt necessary by the Bank based on the Anti-Termite Treatment Control.
2	GENERAL PEST CONTROL Treatment to junction of walls by to entire surface area by spraying of toxicant spray using Beta Cyfluthrin / Deltamethrin solution for crawling insects, paper insects, vectors etc. The treatment shall be carried out on whenever felt necessary by the Bank. (Pest Control treatment area comprises of under furniture/ Equipment's, Staircase, outdoor areas, underground / open sewer / drainage/ storm-water lines, manholes, gully/ inspections chambers etc.)	As well as whenever felt necessary by the Bank based on the General Pest Control
3	RODENT CONTROL TREATMENT Treatment of the entire branch premises using rodenticides such as Bromadiolone, along with application of spray irritants to prevent entry of rats, the treatment shall be carried out on a quarterly basis.	As well as whenever felt necessary by the Bank based on the Rodent Control Treatment

Apart from the above, services shall also be provided on an as-needed basis whenever any pest-related complaint is reported. The agency shall promptly deploy its personnel to attend to such complaints without any additional cost.

All chemicals and formulations used shall be approved, environmentally responsible and compliant with relevant Indian Standards. Only products demonstrating proven efficacy and safety shall be utilized for Anti-Termite Treatment, General Pest Control and Rodent Control Treatment.

1. Imidacloprid, Fipronil, or any other approved active ingredient with equivalent efficacy shall be used for Anti-Termite Treatment and cockroach control under General Pest Control.
2. Deltamethrin, Cyphenothrin, Pyrethrum Extract, or other approved formulations with equivalent efficacy shall be used for mosquito control, including residual spraying as required.
3. All treatments shall be carried out using water-based, low-toxicity, and odorless formulations to ensure safety of occupants, equipment, and the environment, while maintaining high effectiveness against targeted pests.

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Note:

1. The details of materials given above are indicative and the contractor, shall use any other approved chemical, which is eco-friendly and manufacturer, for the effective elimination / alleviation / control/ management of pests with approval of Bank.
2. All pesticides used must be certified for public health/household use under the WHO Pesticide Evaluation Scheme (WHOPES) and must also be registered with the Central Insecticides Board (CIB).
3. For indoor treatment, only pesticides specifically approved for indoor use shall be applied. These should be low-odour and non-staining to the extent possible and must not cause discomfort or inconvenience to the occupants of the premises.
4. Use of approved Chemicals (WHO/BIS- certified, odorless, eco-friendly). No use of banned pesticide and M.S.D.S (Material Safety Data sheet) should be provided by the Agency before start of Work. Expired products are strictly prohibited.
5. Rat Glue pads/ traps should be used in sufficient numbers for Rodent Control Treatment instead of rat kill pesticides.
6. Urgent call must be attended within 24 hours of intimation through any mode of communication.
7. All required chemicals shall be arranged by contractor at his own cost.
8. All termite control jobs shall carry a minimum guarantee of 12 months.
9. The contractor must ensure that pest control measure remain effective between services intervals. If found ineffective, retreatment expense shall be borne by the contractor.
10. Pest control services should be carried out only during holidays or after office hours.
11. Contractor must provide on-call emergency services at no additional cost and maintain a dedicated complaint redressal mechanism.
12. Immediate action is to be taken to resolve pest issue that arise between scheduled treatments.
13. Special care must be taken during rainy season or during mosquito-breeding outbreaks.
14. Pesticides should be pet friendly.
15. The pesticide formulation may be sourced from any reputed manufacturer, such as Envu, Syngenta, FMC, UPL, Bombay Chemicals, Arbuda Chemicals, or any other brand whose product demonstrates equivalent efficacy, safety, and quality standards
16. To prevent pests from developing resistance, pesticides to be used in alternation. No single pesticide shall be applied continuously for more than three months.
17. The contractor shall deploy qualified and experienced staff. All staff must carry identity cards when attending services. Any personnel changes must be promptly notified in writing to the Corporate Service Department.

The treatment shall cover all areas of the branch premises including offices, record rooms, strong rooms, lockers area, toilets, pantry, staircase, storerooms.
- The rates shall remain firm and fixed during the contract period and no escalation shall be permitted.
- The bidder must ensure that all chemicals and materials used are approved and safe as per regulatory standards.
- Any additional work, if required, shall be carried out only with prior approval from the Bank at mutually agreed rates.
- Only approved and safe chemicals should be used. The agency/ firm must ensure that the chemicals used are non-toxic to humans and safe for office environment. The agency/ firm must ensure that the chemicals used are Odourless only.
